The pledge of allegiance was recited.
The Mayor opened the hearing at 6:50pm.

Mayor Putman noted that Chapter 168 of the code of the Village of Round Lake was being discussed with regard to weight limits on local deliveries. He noted that the end part of the delivery must be within the Village limits. Trustee Parker noted that heavy trucks often use Washington Ave as a cut through street. Mayor Putman read through the changes to the chapter with regard to snow emergencies. Mayor Putman closed the hearing at 6:55pm

Mayor Putman opened the second public hearing at 6:55pm to discuss changes to Chapter 125 of the code of the Village of Round Lake. He proposed increasing the fines from \$50 to \$250 for the first littering offense and escalating them thereafter for the second and third offense. Trustee Parker questioned why the cleanup costs are incurred only after the third offense. Trustee Coldrick agreed that cleanup costs should be applied to all offenses of the littering code. This change was agreed by the Board members. The Mayor stated that new 'no littering' signs would be installed.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Samantha Miller asked if Herlihy Road could get a sign as it is a frequent dumping area. She also asked about enforcement and Mayor Putman stated the new laws would be enforced by the code enforcement officer or the local sheriff.
