

PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE TENTATIVE 2010-2011 VILLAGE BUDGET HELD
MARCH 24, 2010 IN THE VILLAGE COMMUNITY ROOM.

Mayor Sacks opened the public hearing at 6:30 P.M.

There was no public present.

Mayor Sacks and the Village Trustees review & discuss the tentative budget.

The amount to be raised by taxes has increased 2%, (\$6,000).

The Village tax rate has lowered from \$5.10 per \$1,000 to \$5.00 per \$1,000.

The changes in salaries are due to changing to the hourly rate rather than by the percentage.

There is an increase in the assessed valuation by 15%, whereas the taxable rate is only up by 4%.

Sales tax revenue was lower from \$127,000 to \$118,000.

Trustee Bergin commented that the Village has a Mayor who works mostly full time. She should receive more for her services than she does.

Trustee Nellissen stated that next years budget should include salaries for the Mayor and Trustees. Some discussion continued.

Mayor Sacks closed the public hearing at 6:55 P.M.
